WHAT IS... **BYOD**

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) is a term used to describe a digital **device ownership** model where students and/or staff use their **privately owned devices** to:

- access the schools networks such as:
 - H: drive for saving personal work
 - **G: drive** for curriculum resources
- access the schools Internet
- printing while at school.







BENEFITS OF... BYOD



- Provides student access to technology at home and school
- Students use a device they are familiar with
- Students can personalise their device to suit their own learning
- Allowing a greater range of parental choice in the purchase of devices
- Enhance **awareness** of emerging technologies.



SUPPORT FOR... SYOD STUDENTS

- **Onboarding** their device to the BYOD system

DAILY TIPS FOR... BYOD

Restart the device daily at home to ensure software is fully up to date.

Bring the device to school fully charged.

Run the BYOx program during form **everyday** with Username and Password. Any problems power off and restart your computer.



PRINTING FOR... STUDENTS



Printers installed include:

- classroom printers
- ASHS Virtual Queue Student

Print credits are managed the same as when you are using a school device.

Your Student ID card is required to release the printing from the copier.



YOUR LAPTOP IS... YOUR DEEDUCIDUUTY

RESPONSIBILITY

You are responsible for the security and care of your own laptop on your way to school, at school including breaks and on the way home from school. It is a very expensive device and you need to be responsible for it at all times.





TREAT YOUR LAPTOP

Always carry your Laptop inside a protective waterproof **backpack** or **hardcase**.

Never leave the device **unattended**, **unprotected** or **on the ground for others to step on "accidentally"**.

If playing on the oval **ensure your bag and laptop are in a safe, visible location.**





YOUR RESPONSIBILITY: DATA SECURITY

Data backup is your responsibility. Please ensure you backup data, in particularly **school work** on a regular basis.

Do this by:

- saving your work to both your Laptop and school H: drive
- Copying Data drive on your laptop to an external HDD regularly
- Emailing assignments/homework to yourself as a backup.






DEVICE REFUELING: MAKING IT LAST

Always fully charge your Laptop each night for the next day.

The core purpose of device at school is for educational purposes.

Don't **waste** your battery on **games**/videos at lunchtime etc. go out and play with your friends.

Laptops can be charged at the library during breaks.





MORE HELPFUL TIPS: LAPTOP CARE

Shut down your device when leaving home. Turn it on when you arrive at school. This will ensure it connects to the network.

Remember to also **shutdown** before leaving school in the afternoon as devices will **overheat** in bags if left on.

Store safely in an appropriate **laptop backpack** or **hardcase**.
