## Principal' Report

Principals Report presented by Shane Haddow (no written report)

Graphs were presented showing how student attendance and engagement in schools is important to learning. Studies show with regular attendance kids have a far better opportunity to successfully achieve a pass in schooling.

Lower attendance is recorded state wide from North of Gympie, strategies are being implemented to encourage school attendance in these areas. Low attendance can effect a child's report card and results achieved.

QParents is a secure, online portal that has been created by the department of Education to provide parents of Queensland State School students with 24hour access to their child's information, it allows you to securely access information about your child and communicate directly with your child's school.

General Business Email was forwarded to all staff for their feedback on the proposed Senior & Junior Day Uniform, Winter Senior & Junior Uniform & Formal Uniform. Only 3 people emailed Megan back but she received a lot of support verbally from staff. Students gave feedback suggesting a "formal uniform day" but this appeared unrealistic as every student would need to buy them. David Burns has supported the new uniforms and just needs to sign off on it. School Captains will go to B & H Designs to purchase the new uniforms. The upcoming year 6's will be encouraged to buy the new uniforms to start their senior year of grade 7. The new uniforms will take approximately 3 years for the transition to happen and thus will effect the year 7,8's & 9's.

Received an email for ideas on gifts for our senior graduating year 12 students. The gift ideas included photo frames, pens & signature bears. In past years the graduating students have received a key ring engraved with their name. Decision to stay with our existing key rings.

Adam Hodgkinson requested a donation from the P &C for the Music Bingo – Formal Fundraiser. Approximately 100 people will be attending and prizes include a \$300 cash prize and \$200 JB Hi Fi vouchers. Food and drinks (non alcoholic) will be provided on the night. Donation of \$500 to be transferred to the school account and also food and drinks will be donated by the canteen. Robyn to organise transfer of money to school account.
