This funding will be used to


- Reduce incidences of negative behaviour to less than 10 referrals per day
- Increase the percentage of excellent and very good behaviour reports to 85%
- Increase the percentage of excellent and very good effort reports to 80%
- Increase the percentage of A and B achievement results to 50%
- Increase attendance to greater than 90%
- Reduce the percentage of students attending less than 85% to less than 25%
- Maintain QCE/QCIA achievement at 100%
- Maintain percentage of OP eligible students achieving OP 1- 15 at >85%
- Improve NAPLAN relative gain to align with the 20:60:20 target for reading and numeracy
- Improve functional literacy and numeracy to 95%

Our school will improve student outcomes by


- Distributive leadership to empower staff to adopt improvement strategies founded in research and aligned to our performance framework – (SIH and DoL)
